The Coach of the Year Award will be awarded and presented annually to a Bankstown Sports Netball Club member or members who display(s) excellence in coaching. Coaches play an exceptionally important role within netball, having the ability to develop and nurture the individual athlete both on and off the court.

Award Description:

The Coach of the Year Award is to be given each year in recognition of outstanding service to the Club in coaching. The recipient of the award is to be judged to have made a significant contribution to coaching, shown exceptional sportsmanship and improved their skills in that season.

Nomination Criteria:

- Be an active member of the Club in that current year
- Be a financial member of the Club
- Be a positive role model
- Acts in the best interest of the Club
- Have outstanding communication and leadership skills
- Displays commitment to the overall development of players, rather than focussing solely on winning
- Demonstrates exemplary sportsmanship towards all concerned (including other teams, parents and umpires)
- Demonstrates commitment to improving their knowledge of coaching by attending approved courses and/or seeking assistance from experienced coaches

Nominations are to be made and seconded, in writing, by two financial members of the Club, using the prescribed form.

Nominations are to be received by the President by the 31st July.

Voting on the award is restricted to two members of the Executive and Coaching Coordinator.
